- A-45-year-old house wife has sustained hot water burn involving front of the chest and front of the abdomen in a kitchen accident. She also had sustained similar burn to forefoot and toes of both feet. Patient was brought in 02 hours after the accident to emergency department. Patient is in severe pain, agitated and affected areas show extensive blisters. Her weight is 60 kg.
  - 1.1 Name two (02) first aid measures that would have been carried out at the site of incident. (10 marks)
  - 1.2 List four (04) main problems requiring early attention. (20 marks)
  - 1.3 List six (06) main immediate general interventions. (30 marks)
  - 1.4 Outline a plan for her fluid management over the next 36-48hrs. (15 marks)
  - 1.5 Briefly explain the management of wounds in the trunk, perineum and toes. (15 marks)
  - 1.6 List two (02) main long term problems this patient is likely to develop. (10 marks)

#### <u>Part B</u>

- 2. A 65-year-old is admitted to the surgical casualty with haematuria.
  - 2.1 List five (05) most likely causes for haematuria in this patient. (20 marks)
  - 2.2 How will you arrive at a diagnosis by history and examination? (60 marks)
  - 2.3 Explain the place of cystoscopy in the management of haematuria. (20 marks)

  - 4.4 Write three (03) possible reasons for reduced urine output during post operative period. (15 marks)
  - 4.5 Outline steps in the management of reduced urine output. (20 marks)
