Why IR is important?

- To display the Institutional Research Visibility (**Affect on University Ranking**)
- To display the University Publications to the world
- To allow Students to access past papers remotely
- To provide authors a URI (Uniform Resource Identifier) for their publication (permanent web address)
- IR Publications automatically indexed in **Google Scholar**

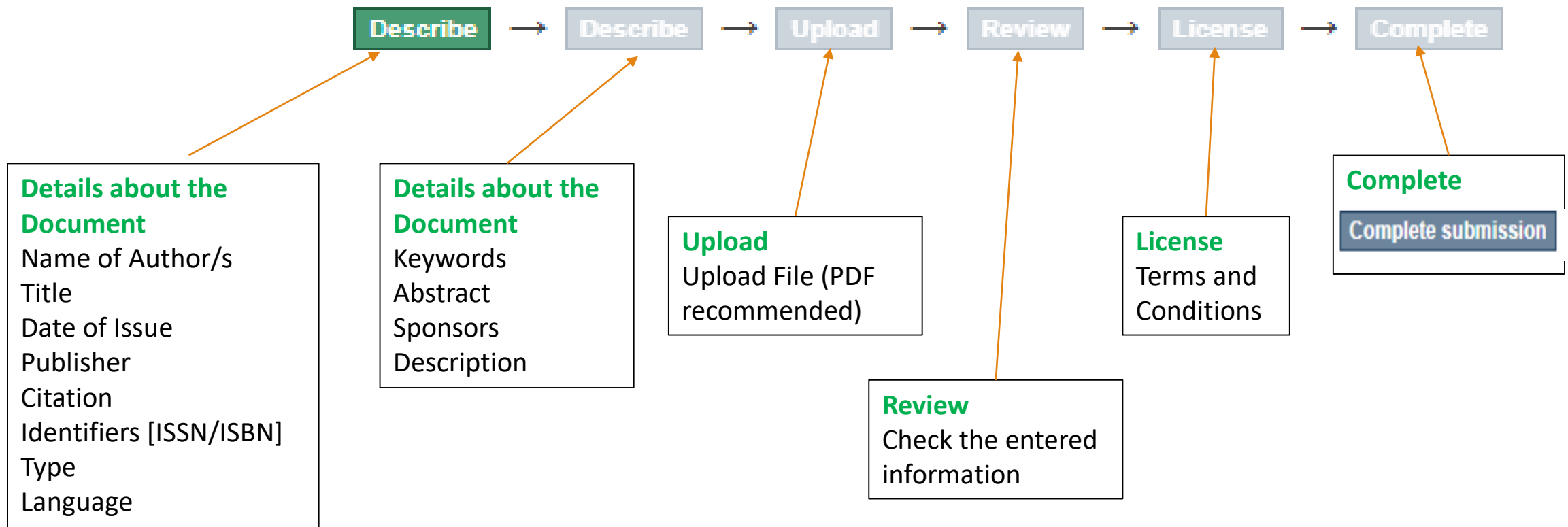

Format: Author, A. A. (Published Year). Title of paper: Subtitle. *Title of proceedings* (page numbers).
Publisher. DOI OR URL if relevant

Bibliographic Information into APA 7th Ed.

Journal Article

Format: Author, A. A., & Author, B. B. (Published Year). Title of article: Subtitle. *Title of Journal*, volume number(issue number), page numbers of the whole article. <https://doi.org/xx.xxx/xxxx>

Author/s Name:
Last Name first and then initials

Publication Year: Do not include date and the month

Article Title: Capitalize the first word and then first word after a colon. Exceptions include proper nouns and acronyms

Journal Title:
Capitalize all of major words and make them italic

Volume Number: Italic and separated from the journal with comma

Issue Number: In Plain text enclosed in parentheses and no space between it and volume number

Page Range: The first and last page numbers of the article with dash between

DOI: The Digital Object Identifier; a unique number assigned to each online articles from an academic journal

Bibliographic Information into APA 7th Ed.

Book

Format: Author, A. A. (Year). *Title of the book: Subtitle of the book*. Publisher Name. DOI or URL (if included)

Publication Year. Do not include month or day, even if they are available.

Palfrey, J. (2015). *BiblioTech: Why libraries matter more than ever in the age of Google*. Basic Books.

Authors. Only use initials for first and middle names. Put a space between initials.

Publisher name. Leave off superfluous words like *Publishers* and *Inc.*, but keep the words *Press* and *Books*.

Book Title. Italicized. Capitalize only the first word and then the first word after a colon (if necessary). Exceptions include proper nouns and acronyms.

Bibliographic Information into APA 7th Ed.

Book Chapter

Format: Author, A. A. (Year). Title of chapter: Subtitle of chapter. In A. A. Editor & B. B. Editor (Eds.), *Title of book: Subtitle of book* (# ed.,* pp. xxx-xxx). Publisher

Chapter Authors. Last name followed by initials. Put a space between initials. Separate authors with commas and insert & before the last author.

Chapter Title. Plain text. Capitalize only the first word and then the first word after a colon, if necessary. Exceptions include proper nouns and acronyms.

Maestriperi, L., Radin, A., & Spina, E. (2019). Methods of sampling in qualitative health research. In M. Saks & J. Allsop (Eds.), *Researching health: Qualitative, quantitative, and mixed methods* (3rd ed., pp. 83-103). Sage.

Book Title. Italicized. Capitalize only the first word and then the first word after a colon, if necessary. Exceptions include proper nouns and acronyms.

Publisher. Leave off superfluous words like Publishers and Inc., but do include the words Press and Books. Publisher location is no longer used.

Book Editors. Initials followed by last name. Put a space between initials. Insert & before the last author. If more than two, separate authors with commas. Add (Eds.) after names.

Additional Info. Use the parentheses after the title to provide page numbers and edition number beyond the first edition.
