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1. Acute Haemolytic Transfusion Reaction was reported from the ward during the transfusion of red cell concentrate to a 30-year old male who is anaemic. Investigations revealed that ABO incompatible blood transfusion was given to this patient due to a blood grouping error happened at the Blood Bank, although correct sample was received from the patient.
- 1.1. What are the critical points at which this error can happen in the Blood Bank? (30 marks)
- 1.2. State how would you take measures to prevent this type of errors? (40 marks)
- 1.3. What are investigations you should be carried out in the blood bank? (30 marks)
2. Complaint was received from a clinician of the hospital that platelet increment is very poor after platelet transfusions. He pointed out that it is due to quality failure.
- 2.1. What are the factors which affect the quality of platelets in the blood pack in the blood donation center? (30 marks)
- 2.2. Describe how you would ensure the quality of platelet concentrate prepared at blood bank. (40 marks)
- 2.3. What are the parameters you should check to assess the quality of platelet concentrate? (30 marks)
