SURVEY ON ONLINE LIBRARY SERVICES PROVIDED DURING THE COVID PANDEMIC SITUATION: WITH SPECIAL REFERENCE TO ACADEMIC LIBRARIES OF SRI LANKA.

The COVID-19 pandemic can be considered as a turning point of the usual civil life of many people. It has also challenged the conventional teaching and learning methods at all levels of education. The university education system too was affected drastically by the pandemic. This has resulted a move towards the adoption of online teaching and learning methods to continue education programmes in universities. Being a main information service provider, the academic library has a significant role in providing support for online teaching and learning activities of a university. Present study aimed to investigate about the online library services provided by the 15 state university libraries coming under the purview of the University Grants Commission in Sri Lanka, as a response to the "new normal" condition. An online survey was conducted to investigate the online services provided through the websites of the 15 state university libraries under similar conditions and at the same time. Results revealed that almost all libraries provided OPACs, institutional repositories, online databases with off-campus access together with other conventional online services. Further, provision of article indexes, digital document delivery services, government publications, library tours, LMS links, open access books, recommended reading downloads, subject liaison services, voice libraries, and laptop lending services emerged as new services. It could be concluded that the present period of time is the best time period to venture into new services and taking steps to meet the requirements of the changing society.
