The term politics is derived from the Greek word “Polis”, which means the city-state. That was the general form of political organization in ancient Greece. The word is indebted to the Greek philosophers who systematized the science of politics into a definite and distinct branch of knowledge.

Prior to the Greek the ancient Egyptians, Babylonians, Persians, Indians and Chinese had developed political ideas and dwelt upon political institutions. But it was the Greeks who developed a systematic study of the nature, purpose and the functions of the state and its relation to man. They embarked upon the study of the state as distinct from the church and as the custodian of public welfare. They also attempted the study of politics as the sciences of state craft.

Socrates was the first Greek thinker. His disciple was Plato. But it was Aristotle who is rightly called the father of political sciences. He stated that man is a political animal by nature and necessity. He is a gregarious animal. Therefore he must live an organized life under one political organization. It is in the state that man can reach the highest ideals of life. It is the state that provides necessary conditions wherein he can satisfy all his needs and find all-sided development of his personality.
